The City of Mandeville, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the City's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located along Lakeshore Drive along the extent of the existing seawall. The flood hazard revisions are being proposed as part of Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) Case No. 19-06-2084R for a proposed project along Lake Pontchartrain. The City is considering raising the existing concrete cap on the seawall by approximately one foot to decrease base flood elevations and to aid in dissipating wave energy that leads to nuisance flooding along Lakeshore Drive. This may result in reduced flood insurance premiums for many homes south of Monroe Street.

Once the project has been completed, a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) request should be submitted that will, in part, revise the following flood hazards along Lake Pontchartrain.

Base Flood Elevations will decrease along Lake Pontchartrain.

The Special Flood Hazard Area will decrease along Lake Pontchartrain.

The City is holding a **public hearing** on Wednesday, September 18th in the Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. Maps and detailed analysis of the revision can be previewed at Mandeville City Hall at 3101 E.
