THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY APPLICATION FOR FY 2023-2024 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRM (LGAP) GRANT FUNDING AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITHIN
WHEREAS, the purpose of the Local Government Assistance Program (LGAP) is to provide financial assistance to local units of government in rural areas; and
WHEREAS, the City of Mandeville qualifies as an eligible participant in the FY 2023-2024 Local Government Assistance Program (LGAP) program; and
WHEREAS, the administration has identified a project which qualifies as an eligible activity under the Local Government Assistance Program (LGAP) grant requirements; and
WHEREAS, the grant application will request funding forsidewalk repairs and extensions, including handicapped curbed ramps for the improved accessibility along St. Ann Drive from Elmwood Place (Service Road) to US 190; and
WHEREAS, the sidewalk repairs and extensions will improve the accessibility on the St. Ann Drive corridor from Elmwood Place (Service Rd) to US 190. This ½ mile St. Ann corridor consists of multifamily residential, businesses, and it backs up to one of the largest retail centers in the City of Mandeville Sidewalk does not exist on one quarter of the corridor, there are a number of locations that require repair, and several intersections that do not have ADA compliant crossings. This corridor receives heavy traffic through peak periods of the day and these sidewalk extensions and upgrades will allow for safe access and travel for non-vehicular modes. The sidewalks and handicapped curb ramps will be constructed and placed by the City's Roadway and Drainage Maintenance Contractor.
