RESOLUTION NO.25-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE TO SUBMIT A PRE-APPLICATION AND SUBSEQUENT APPLICATION TO THE STATEWIDE FLOOD CONTROL PROGRAM FOR ASSISTANCE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDUCING EXISTING FLOOD DAMAGES IN THE WELDON PARK SUBDIVISION; PROVIDING FOR THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION OF SAID FLOOD DAMAGES; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Mandeville, particularly in the Weldon Park Subdivision, has been adversely affected by damages from flood waters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mandeville desires to apply for State matching funds pursuant to L.S. R.S. 38:90.1 et. Seq., as amended to implement a project to reduce said flood damages and that the City is fully aware of its obligations under said Statute; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mandeville is a political body duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Louisiana and is eligible to apply for funds under said Statute; and

WHEREAS, the State has made funds available pursuant to the above Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Mandeville as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Mandeville acknowledges that upon approval of the pre-application, a formal application will be prepared and submitted to the Louisiana Statewide Flood Control Program.

Section 2. That at the appropriate time and upon approval of funding assistance and prior to commencement of work on the project the City of Mandeville agrees to execute a Statement of Sponsorship pursuant to said Statute.

Section 3.

- a. That Mayor Clay Madden is hereby Authorized Representative for the City of Mandeville to represent the City of Mandeville to affect the preparation and submission of the pre-application and application to the Statewide Flood Control Program for funding assistance of a flood control project.
- b. That Mayor Clay Madden has designated the City's Public Works Director, Keith LaGrange, Jr., P.E., to address all technical matters in the preparation of the pre-application and application to the Statewide Flood Control Program for funding assistance of a flood control project.

Section 4. That the responsibilities of Keith LaGrange, Jr., P.E., shall pertain to technical matters only and shall not include any official act on behalf of the City of Mandeville.

With the above resolution having been properly introduced and duly seconded, the vote was as follows:


