NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Mandeville, in regular session assembled, that it does hereby accept the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee to award the contract for the 2025 Standby Emergency Debris Removal and Disposal Services to JWTC-Louisiana, LLC.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Mandeville hereby authorizes Mayor Clay Madden to execute a contract and all necessary related documents between the City of Mandeville and JWTC-Louisiana, LLC, based on the terms, conditions, and unit pricing set forth in their proposal dated August 4, 2025.
