**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE TO EXECUTE
AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE DEBRIS MONITORING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
CITY OF MANDEVILLE AND TETRA TECH, INC. AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER
MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

WHEREAS, the City entered into a standby debris monitoring contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. for professional debris monitoring services in the event of a hurricane or other emergency condition on October 12, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the original contract had a duration of three (3) years from the effective date ; and

WHEREAS, the agreed upon hourly rates are subject to an annual adjustment based on the latest yearly percentage increase of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) (All Items) as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor now desire to further amend the Agreement to add an additional calendar year for the Consultant to continue performing the described services and update the agreed upon hourly rates as set forth in the original contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Mandeville, hereby authorizes and empowers the Mayor of the City to execute Amendment No. 1 to the debris monitoring contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. on behalf of the City of Mandeville to add one additional calendar year from the end of the current expiration date to the new date of October 11, 2026 and to increase Tetra Tech's hourly rates by 2.55%, based on the CPI-U.
