**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE TO EXECUTE  
AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE AND HIGH TIDE CONSULTANTS, LLC  
FOR OLD GOLDEN SHORES DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR  
OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

**WHEREAS**, on December 22, 2022, the City of Mandeville (“City”) and High Tide Consultants, LLC (“Consultant”) entered into a Professional Services Agreement (“Agreement”), for professional engineering services to the City for the Old Golden Shores Drainage Improvements Project; and

**WHEREAS**, there was an Amendment No.1 passed on December 19, 2024, extending the Agreement for an additional year from the contract expiration date to December 22, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to amend the Professional Services Agreement, to add an additional one (1) year to allow time for the Consultant to continue performing the professional services for design, permitting, bidding, and construction administration; and


**WHEREAS**, no change in fees or scope to this Agreement is required at this time;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Mandeville, hereby authorizes and empowers the Mayor of the City to amend the Professional Services Agreement with High Tide Consultants, LLC and execute Amendment No. 2 to extend the Professional Services Agreement for one (1) year which brings the current Agreement expiration date to December 22, 2026.


With the above resolution having been properly introduced and duly seconded, the vote was as follows:
