RESOLUTION NO. 26-06

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE TO EXECUTE
AMENDMENT NO.2 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE AND CSRS, LLC AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER
MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Professional Services Agreement with CSRS, LLC (“Consultant”), through which Consultant provides professional services to the City of Mandeville for a hydraulic impact analysis for the Ravine Aux Coquille Watershed Modeling Project and has been in effect since June 28, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently undergoing litigation that may require the services of CSRS personal to provide professional testimony as it relates to hydraulic and hydrologic modeling efforts, and these services would increase the consultant’s fee by a not to exceed amount of \$10,000.00, which is inclusive of engineering design and other supplement services; and

WHEREAS, the City also sees the need to extend the CSRS, LLC contract time two (2) years from March 28, 2026 to March 28, 2028 for the consultant to be able to continue providing engineering design, bidding, construction administration, project closeout services, and inspection services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Mandeville, hereby authorizes and empowers the Mayor of the City to amend the June 28, 2023 Professional Services Agreement with CSRS, LLC, as set forth in Amendment No. 2 to the Professional Services Agreement to increase the total Consultant’s fee by an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 and also add two (2) years to the contract time for continued services.

With the above resolution having been properly introduced and duly seconded, the vote was as follows:




