**RESOLUTION NO. 26-22**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NO.1 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE AND KYLE ASSOCIATES, LLC. AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Consultant are parties to a professional services agreement dated on May 13, 2024 (the “**Agreement**”) to provide professional services for the final design, bidding, construction engineering and resident inspection services, in addition to DOTD coordination efforts, for the new landscaping and lighting for Girod Street from Montgomery Street to U.S. Highway 190 in the City of Mandeville; and

**WHEREAS**, as per the Consultant’s May 9, 2026 letter request, the City and the Consultant now desire to amend the original Agreement to reallocate previously approved Phase V(b) fee for resident inspection services to Phase V(a) for construction engineering services due to the ongoing DOTD coordination and required project management and oversight during the construction phase of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Consultant also further desire to further amend the Agreement to add one (1) additional year for the Consultant to continue services of the Agreement for the Girod Street Landscaping & Lighting, Phase III Project, ending it on May 13, 2027; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Mandeville, hereby authorizes and empowers the Mayor of the City to execute Amendment No.1 to the Professional Services Agreement with Kyle Associates, LLC., to reallocate the Phase V(b) fee for resident inspection services to Phase V(a) for construction engineering services and add one (1) additional year to the Agreement date, ending it May 13, 2027.

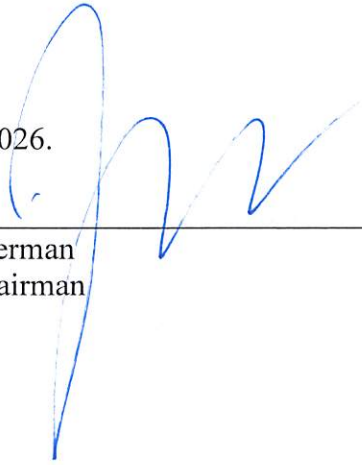
