



# MANDEVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

The city's crime statistics for the 2024 calendar year are now posted on the city's website. I am pleased to report that overall crime figures for the City of Mandeville are holding steady, and in some categories continue to trend down.

In 2024, the police department received 18,584 calls for service. Just as it was last year, the leading complaint the department received from the public was traffic related. Although the city's population is relatively stable, the areas surrounding the city continue to expand. When analyzing the area and population under the jurisdiction of the Mandeville Police Department, it is important to realize our city is not isolated and is part of a much larger population center. Accordingly, the Mandeville Police Department is confronted with issues, especially when it pertains to traffic, of a much larger city. Although traffic in the area continues to increase, the number of traffic accidents in 2024 was near a five-year low.

To proactively address the City of Mandeville's increasing traffic volume, traffic enforcement activities were increased, resulting in 9,417 traffic enforcement actions taken. This is up from the 6,018 enforcement actions taken in 2023. The 9,417 traffic enforcement actions were at a five year high.

Residential burglaries, business burglaries, and vehicle burglaries were all at five-year lows.

In 2024, our community suffered from two individuals losing their lives as result of a tragic domestic dispute. Although tragic, this is in no way indicative of an uptick in violent crime.

I firmly believe Mandeville's relatively low crime rate can be attributed to the following factors: the citizens of the City of Mandeville, the professionalism of the Mandeville Police Department, and the tremendous support the department receives from the mayor's office, as well as the support of the city council.

Although we can never guarantee that crimes will not be committed and traffic laws will not be violated, rest assured the Mandeville Police Department will do everything within our power to deter crime and help hold those who choose to ignore the law accountable for their actions.
