ORDINANCE NO. 21-11

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE PROHIBITING EXTENDED
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ALONG A PORTION OF GENERAL PERSHING
STREET, SQUARE 46, LYING BETWEEN LAFITTE STREET AND GIROD STREET,
FOR ANY PERIOD OF TIME LONGER THAN SIX (6) HOURS ON ALL DAYS,
INCLUDING HOLIDAYS, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF
AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

WHEREAS, the City of Mandeville desires to ensure available public parking along General Pershing Street, Square 46, lying between Lafitte Street and Girod Street;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that said public parking be limited to six (6) hours per day by individual motor vehicles to ensure access to and appropriate use of the same public parking by as many unique and individual motor vehicles as possible;

WHEREAS, the City Council opines that a time limitation for parking along General Pershing Street will ensure and improved public use of the property for shorter periods of time,

WHEREAS, Section 10-64 of the City of Mandeville Code of Ordinances allows the Mayor and the Councilmen to regulate, restrict or prohibit the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on specified areas, and the same ordinance requires the City to install signs or markings to give notice of such regulations, restrictions and prohibitions; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-64 of the City of Mandeville Code of Ordinances states that it shall be unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to violate or fail to comply with any sign prohibiting parking and be subject to a fine for any violation thereof;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, the City Council pursuant to the authority vested in the City Council and Mayor under the provisions of Section 10-64 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Mandeville, that the stopping, standing or parking of motor vehicles be prohibited along General Pershing Street, Square 46, lying between Lafitte Street and Girod Street be limited to any period of time less than six (6) hours on all days of the week, including holidays; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that signs or markings be installed along the aforesaid section of General Pershing Street giving notice of the aforementioned prohibition of stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED any person or persons found to have violated the provisions of this ordinance be fined an amount of not more than \$150.00

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the signature of the Mayor;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Clerk of this Council be, and she is hereby authorized and empowered to take any and all actions which she, in the exercise of her discretion, deems necessary to promulgate the provisions of this Ordinance.
