A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANDEVILLE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES ON HOW ORDINANCES, WITH RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION, ARE PLACED ON THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING AGENDAS AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, Section 2-06 (c) of the Mandeville Home Rule Charter states the City Council shall determine by Resolution its own rules and order of business, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to clarify agenda notice requirements and procedures relating to how ordinances requested by the Planning and Zoning Commission are placed on Council agendas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide a more efficient process in the introduction, discussion and adoption of ordinances that come before the Council as a request from the Planning and Zoning Commission, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to formalize the agenda process to improve planning and to enhance communication between the Administration, the Planning and Zoning Commission, and the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mandeville that the following rule is established:

Any ordinance offered to the City Council by the Planning and Zoning Commission shall not be advertised on the City Council agenda prior to public hearing and recommendation by the Planning and Zoning Commission.
