**WHEREAS**, The City Council introduced Ordinance 21-02 at their March 11,2021 meeting. The ordinance included Whereas language that suggested the need for the City to retain an expert in drafting and reviewing Sign Ordinances to review the entire Article of the CLURO addressing the City's sign code, regulations and enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission at their meeting held on April 27, 2021 voted unanimously and made a recommendation to City Council to move forward with a consultant to review signed ordinances with the assistance and appropriate scope necessary from the City's legal team as well as the Planning & Zoning team; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is requesting this review to be addressed in the budgeting process and included in the Planning & Zoning short term work program

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Mandeville in special session assembled on the 24th day of June 2021 acting pursuant to the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission that the review of entire Article of the CLURO addressing the City's sign code, regulations and enforcement, be addressed in the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget.
